B. New Subject Areas

Observations:

- City College created 12 new subject areas over the last five years which increased the number of student course enrollments by 3,309. Enrollment in the Computer Business Technology courses accounts for a large proportion (72%) of this increase since it began in Fall 1999.**
- Mesa College had 6,549 new student course enrollments in 10 new subject areas, of which, 4,244 were in the Computer Business Technology program.**
- Student course enrollment increased by 1,446 in 4 new subject areas at Miramar College.**
- Student course enrollment at ECC increased by 155 as a result of introducing two new subject areas.**
