

# VI. Future Projections

- ❑ In 1998, the California Postsecondary Education Commission (CPEC) predicted that the enrollment increase in California public colleges and universities would continue in the first decade of the new millennium.
- ❑ The growth will vary according to the type of institutional system: 36% at the California Community Colleges, 37% at California State University and 32% at the University of California.
- ❑ According to SANDAG, the District service area adult population was projected to grow by 13.4% from 1990 to 2000 and by 21.2% from 2000 to 2020. However, the actual adult population growth from 1990 to 2000 for SDCCD was 6.1%, a decrease of 7.3% from the initial projection.
- ❑ The District's enrollment will be impacted by the enrollment growth of the service areas. Census projections indicate that from 2000 to 2020, with one exception (Grossmont-Cuyamaca), the District's constituencies will grow at a slower rate than other community college service areas in the county.
