

## **Section 1.4 High School Students Currently Enrolled in the District**

Approximately three to four percent of all students enrolled in the district are concurrent high school students. This section describes a previous year cohort (fall 2001) of concurrently enrolled high school students in terms of their term retention (Table 10) and fall-to-spring persistence (Table 11). In addition, the extent to which these students return as regular admits during fall 2002 is examined (see Table 12).

As can be seen in Table 10, 92% of the concurrently enrolled high school students from the district feeders completed the fall 2001 term, while only 62% of the students from non-district feeders completed the same term. In terms of fall-to-spring persistence, the data in Table 11 showed persistence rates of 78% and 24% for concurrently enrolled high school students from district and non-district feeders respectively. Finally, 23% of district feeder and 29% of non-district feeder students who were concurrently enrolled high school students in fall 2001 returned in fall 2002 as regular college admits.
