

Chapter 4: First-year Performance in the District

This Chapter describes how first-time students from the feeder high schools performed during their first academic year (fall and spring semester). In order to provide retention and persistence information, the prior year cohort (June 2001 high school graduates) was used. This chapter is divided into three sections: retention and persistence rates, unit and course completion, and term grade point average.

Section 4.1 Retention and Persistence Rates

This section provides retention and persistence rates for the June 2001 high school graduate cohort. The rates include, first-term retention, persistence from fall 2001 to spring 2002, and persistence from fall 2001 to fall 2002.

The data described below reflect first-time college students from the high school feeders enrolled at SDCCD in fall 2001.

FIRST-TERM RETENTION: (Table 45 – District & Non-District Feeders)

- Over 90 percent of the students in the June 2001 high school graduate cohort from both district (91%) and non-district (93%) feeders completed their first semester (fall 2001).

TERM-TERM PERSISTENCE: (Table 46 – District & Non-District Feeders)

- Of the students in the June 2001 high school graduate cohort, 82% of the district feeder students persisted to the spring semester (spring 2002), while only 72% of the non-district feeder students persisted.

FALL-TO-FALL PERSISTENCE: (Table 47 – District & Non-District Feeders)

- The persistence rate from fall 2001 to fall 2002 for the June 2001 high school graduate cohort was 67% for the district feeders and 56% for the non-district feeders.
