

Section 4.3 Term Grade Point Average

The distribution of term grade point averages (GPA) for the June 2001 high school graduate cohort is reported in this section. Students' academic performance, as reflected by term GPA, is provided for both fall 2001 and spring 2002 semesters. *Note: Individual high schools are identified by a number which was randomly assigned.*

The data described below reflect first-time college students from the high school feeders enrolled at City College in fall 2001.

TERM GPA: (Table 64 – District Feeders; Table 65 – Non-District Feeders)

- About one-fourth (27%) of the students from district feeder students had a semester GPA between 3.00 and 4.00 in fall 2001. Another 34% had a GPA between 2.00 and 2.99 and 39% were below 2.00. However, in spring 2002, only 23% of the students from district feeders had a semester GPA between 3.00 and 4.00.
- For the students from non-district feeders, 37% had semester GPA's between 3.00 and 4.00 and 33% had GPA's between 2.00 and 2.99 in fall 2001. In addition, 29% of the non-district students had a GPA below 2.00. However, in spring 2002, the percent of non-district students with GPAs below 2.00 increased to 42%.
