

Section 1.5 2002 Degree and Certificate Recipients

The extent to which students from the district's high school feeders have attained their educational goals (e.g., associate degree, certificates) is described in this section. Although degree and certificate recipients at Mesa College originate from high schools throughout the country and state, only recipients whose high school of origin were district and non-district feeders listed in this report were included. The results are listed in Table 13. The total number of associate degrees and certificates awarded by Mesa College in 2002 was 1,527. The data in Table 13 show that 410 or 27% of these awards were given to students who came from one of the district feeder schools. Another 130 (8%) awards were given to students who came from one of the non-district feeder schools.
