

Chapter 2: Pre-College Characteristics of Feeder Students

The primary cohort interest for this report is the June 2002 high school graduates who enrolled in Miramar College as first-time students in fall 2002. This chapter consists of three sections that describe the enrollment patterns and pre-college characteristics of these students. In particular, Section 2.1 describes what percent of the June 2002 high school graduates enrolled in Miramar College, while the data in Sections 2.2 and 2.3 examine demographic (e.g., gender and ethnicity) and academic (e.g., high school GPA, high school course completion) pre-college characteristics respectively.

Section 2.1 Percent of High School Graduates

The data in Table 14 show the percent of each district feeder high school's graduating class enrolled in Miramar College in fall 2000, fall 2001, and fall 2002. As can be seen, the percentages for fall 2002 ranged from less than 1% to 34%. On average, approximately five percent of the high school graduates enrolled in Miramar College in fall 2002. In addition, data for the previous two years (2000 and 2001) showed a similar pattern. The data in Table 15 show the percent of each non-district feeder high school's graduating class enrolled in the district in fall 2000, fall 2001, and fall 2002. Compared to the district feeders, the percentages for the non-district feeders were smaller, ranging from less than 0% to 15%.
